## Travel Declaration for June School Holidays

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If your child/ward is travelling during the June school holidays, please make the necessary declaration for her via Parents' Gateway (PG) under Services -> Declare Travels. If there is a need to amend the travel plan, you can do so via the same module in PG. If your child/ward is not travelling during the holidays, **no action is required**.

## 2025 P1 Registration Exercise - Phase 1

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Phase 1 registration is for a Singapore Citizen (SC) or Permanent Resident (PR) child born between 2 January 2019 and 1 January 2020 (both dates inclusive) and has an older sibling currently studying in our primary school.

Parents/Guardians who are registering their child/ward under Phase 1 are to register via <https://go.gov.sg/moe-p1-reg-portal> during the Phase 1 registration period from 9am on 1 July 2025 to 4.30pm on 3 July 2025.

If your child/ward is a non-SC / non-PR and thus not eligible for Phase 1, please submit an online Indication of Interest via <https://www.moe.gov.sg/primary/p1-registration/international-students> from 9am on 27 May 2025 to 4.30pm on 2 June 2025.
