## National Day Celebration

The school will celebrate National Day on Friday, 8 August 2025. The theme is “Majulah Singapura”

As we mark 60 years of independence, this year’s theme invites us to reflect on the road we have walked as one people, and to look ahead with hope, courage, and unity.

**All students are to report to school by 7.25am and will be dismissed at 10.30am.** To minimise overcrowding, we will implement staggered dismissal:

P1 & P2	P3 & P4	P5 & P6
10.10am	10.20am	10.30am

As the bookshop and canteen will be closed, we will implement snack time for all levels instead. There will be no afternoon activities that day, i.e. support lessons, P6 supplementary lessons and CCA. Please make the necessary transport arrangements for your child/ward to return home if she is not taking the school bus.

Students are encouraged to wear a red T-shirt with their pinafore and school shoes. They should bring along a small bag with a water bottle, a story book, stationery and some healthy dry snacks.



# General Information

## Instilling Responsibility - Being Punctual

---

We seek parents' /guardians' assistance to ensure that your child/ward is punctual for school. Assembly begins promptly at 7.30am, and students who are not with their class for assembly at 7.30am will be considered late. As such, please ensure that your child/ward factor in time taken to get to her class or the school hall before 7.30am so that she can be with her class punctually for the flag-raising ceremony.

There are consequences for late-coming. These guidelines can be found in the school organiser page 25. Students who are consistently late may face further consequences such as the removal of privileges which could include exclusion from school celebrations or recesses.

**1.PSLE Oral (13 and 14 August 2025)**

**2.PSLE Listening Comprehension (16 September 2025)**

The PSLE Oral and Listening Comprehension examinations for Primary 6 students will take place on the dates stated above. **There will be no school for P1 - P5 students on the above dates.**

To ensure a safe and conducive environment for the examination, the school will not admit visitors on these days. This includes parents, caregivers and P1 to P5 students for non-emergency cases, e.g. collection of homework or retrieval of lost items. Please remind your child/ward to bring home whatever she needs. A few canteen stalls will be

open on the day of the PSLE Listening Comprehension (i.e. 16 September 2025) to cater to the Primary 6 students. However, the bookshop and dental clinic will be closed on these 3 days.

### **3. PSLE Written Papers (25 September to 1 October 2025)**

The PSLE Written examinations for Primary 6 students will take place from 25 September to 1 October. P6 students are dismissed at the end of each paper. **P1 to P5 students will report to school for lessons as usual on these days.**

### **PSLE Marking Exercise from 13 to 15 October 2025**

---

The PSLE Marking Exercise will take place from 13 to 15 October 2025. These 3 days are non-school days for P1 to P6 students. However, the school will be conducting **Swimsafer Programme for P4 students** as well as **support lessons for selected P3 and P5 students**. P3 and P5 students selected for the support lessons will be informed via Parents Gateway by end September.

### **Travel Declaration for Long Weekends**

---

If your child/ward is travelling during the National Day long weekend, please make the necessary declaration for her via Parents' Gateway (PG) under Services -> Declare Travels. If there is a need to amend the travel plan, you can do so via the same module in PG. If your child is **not** travelling during the holidays or the long weekends, **no action is required**.

## Absences from Weighted Assessments

---

As with any school day, a student should not be in school if she is unwell. Please make the necessary arrangements to bring your child/ward to see a doctor and submit the medical certificate to the Form Teacher upon her return to school. This applies on days when Weighted Assessments take place too.

The purpose of assessment including Weighted Assessments is to check for students' understanding and to provide timely feedback to improve learning. As such, while make-up sessions will not be scheduled for students who are absent from any component(s)/paper(s), **students who miss their written assessment will be given a set of the affected assessment papers as an optional assignment.** They are encouraged to complete the paper at home independently and at one sitting. The subject teacher will mark the assignment and provide feedback on the student's progress. The marks will not be included in the computation of the Overall Performance for the year.

We seek your cooperation to inculcate in our students the need to be responsible and take ownership of their learning in school.
