Teachers' Day Celebration

All students are to report to school by 7.25am and will be dismissed at 10.30am. To minimise overcrowding, we will implement staggered dismissal:

As the bookshop and canteen will be closed, we will implement snack time for all levels instead. There will be no afternoon activities that day, i.e. support lessons, P6 supplementary lessons and CCA. Students should bring along a small bag with a water bottle, a story book, stationery and some healthy dry snacks. Please make the necessary transport arrangements for your child/ward to return home if she is not taking the school bus.

The following day (Teachers' Day on Friday, 5 September 2025) is a school holiday. The General Office will be closed at 5.00pm on 5 September 2025.

Children's Day Celebration

The school will celebrate Children's Day on Thursday, 2 October 2025. We will be having activities and picnic in the class and ending the day with a concert.

All students are to report to school by 7.25am and will be dismissed at 10.30am.

We will implement the same arrangement as Teachers' Day mentioned above, hence please refer to the instructions for staggered dismissal timings, snack time and parents' choice of transport arrangements.

The following day (Children's Day on Friday, 3 October 2025) is a school holiday. The General Office will be closed at 5.00pm on 3 October 2025.

Travel Declaration for September School Holidays

If your child/ward is travelling during the school holidays, please make the necessary declaration for her via Parents' Gateway (PG) under Services -> Declare Travels. If there is a need to amend the travel plan, you can do so via the same module in PG. If your child is not travelling during the holidays or the long weekends, no action is required.

Fee Arrears

Parents with outstanding school fees/miscellaneous fees would have received notification letters from MOE to make payment. Please approach Mdm Maliga from the General Office if you have any concerns. For Primary 6 students, outstanding fees should be paid before the release of the PSLE results, i.e. around mid-Nov 2025.

Safety Reminders

Keeping CHIJ OLN a Safe Environment for Students - Arrival and Dismissal

We would like to reiterate the following safety reminders:

- During dismissal, parents/guardians who drive are requested to park at the designated parking lots at the Multi Storey Carpark or open-air carpark. Please be considerate and do not inconvenience residents in the vicinity and other road users by parking illegally along the main road before the bus-stop as accidents may happen. Please time your arrival after dismissal so that your children/wards are waiting for you at the pavement. This allows them to board quickly and you can drive off without posing any danger to other road users.
- For parents/guardians who take the public bus, please ensure safety for the students by standing behind the yellow lines and bollards while waiting at the bus stop. Do not rush or push forward while the bus enters the bus bay as anyone might fall and be seriously injured. Please queue and board safely and move inwards towards the back to make way for other commuters to board the buses. Please wait for the next bus if it is full.
- All parents/guardians, especially domestic helpers, are reminded not to block the pedestrian walkways or sit on the steps of the overhead bridge while waiting for their child/ward as you cause inconvenience to residents and members of the public. They need the space on the steps and to hold on to the railings for support, especially the elderly and those requiring support in their movement.
- Once the students are dismissed, we seek your cooperation to take the children home for their lunch and

rest. We request that domestic helpers do not sit around to chat near the overhead bridge, leaving students on their own to play at the bus stop or the walkway.

We appreciate your support and will continue to work with you closely to keep all students safe. Let us all do our part to exercise personal and social responsibility.

PSLE Examination Dates

1. PSLE Listening Comprehension (16 September 2025)

The PSLE Listening Comprehension examinations for Primary 6 students will take place on the date stated above. **There will be no school for P1 - P5 students on the above date.**

To ensure a safe and conducive environment for the examination, the school will not admit visitors on these days. This includes parents, caregivers and P1 to P5 students for non-emergency cases, e.g. collection of homework or retrieval of lost items. Please remind your child/ward to bring home whatever she needs. A few canteen stalls will be open on the day of the PSLE Listening Comprehension (i.e. 16 September 2025) to cater to the Primary 6 students. However, the bookshop and dental clinic will be closed.

2. PSLE Written Papers (25 September to 1 October 2025)

The PSLE Written examinations for Primary 6 students will take place from 25 September to 1 October. P6 students are dismissed at the end of each paper. **P1 to P5 students will report to school for lessons as usual on these days.**

PSLE Marking Exercise from 13 to 15 October 2025

The PSLE Marking Exercise will take place from 13 to 15 October 2025. These 3 days are non-school days for P1 to P6 students. However, the school will be conducting **Swimsafer Programme for P4 students** as well as **support lessons for selected P3 and P5 students**. P3 and P5 students selected for the support lessons will be informed via Parents Gateway by end September.
